

# Late Work Policy

## 6<sup>th</sup> Grade

### Daily Assignments

Turned in one day late lose 10%. Turned in beyond one day late lose 50%. Individual teachers will establish how many days past due date they will accept late work.

## 7<sup>th</sup> Grade

Daily Assignments-Homework is a nightly expectation. If you do not hand in your homework you are Bugged. Options are:

Stay after school in the Bug room and complete assignment for no penalty.

OR

Use your BUG out Pass – 2 each quarter. You will hand in completed assignment the next day for no penalty. If students do not use BUG passes they can use for extra credit – 5 pts per pass, one per class.

OR

Turn in completed assignment to your teacher by 2:40 on the day it is due and receive 25% penalty.

OR

Turn in completed assignment one or more days late for 50%.

Long Term projects will be not be part of BUG – teachers will outline expectations for individual projects.

## 8<sup>th</sup> Grade

Each student receives 3 “Free Late” passes each quarter. These are used if something special arises that interferes with completing required homework. The student uses one of these passes without penalty if homework is not complete. The expectation is that completed homework will be turned in the following day.

### Daily Assignments

50% loss of credit if not turned in during assigned class period.

### Longer Term Projects

Up to 50% loss of credit, to be negotiated between individual student and teacher.

- Individual teachers will determine and communicate individual preferences for how much time from assignment due date they will continue to accept late work
- ASK is available to all students who sign up and need a quiet place with supervision and assistance as needed.

- Students may turn in unused “Free Late” passes, one per teacher, for up to 5 points of extra credit.
