

Mounds View Public Schools Ends and Goals Regulation

EG-3103 School Safety & Crisis Response

The following regulations are for Policy EG-3103. These regulations provide procedures for maximizing maintenance of safe school environments.

1. Each school will have on file a copy of their school safety and crisis response plan.
2. The District office will have on file a copy of their safety and crisis response plan as well as copies of all other building safety and crisis response plans.
3. Each school, at the direction of the Superintendent, will conduct a yearly safe climate self- assessment. This assessment will examine, but is not limited to, the following:
 - a. Student discipline: Incidents, severity, policies, and procedures.
 - b. Review of school safety plan and planning process.
 - c. Review of staff training relative to safety issues.
 - d. Review of the school/law enforcement partnership and the relationship with local community leaders and resources.
 - e. Review of crisis response plan.
 - f. School access and supervision.
 - g. Student, staff, and community feedback regarding school climate
4. The principal of the school and a representative of the District office will meet annually with a representative of the local law enforcement agency that services the school to review school safety and crisis plans and make alterations as deemed appropriate.
5. Principals are encouraged to attend, or send staff representatives to continuing education seminars relating to school safety issues. Examples include: violence prevention, character education, student discipline, supervision, etc.
6. All District personnel, pursuant to Policy EG-3103 – School Safety and Crisis Response will wear District authorized photo identification badges.
