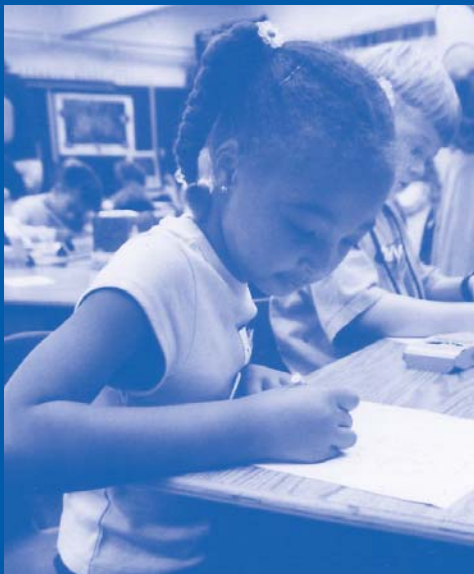


Mounds View schools will educate all learners through a broad range of programs that set high expectations and inspire outstanding achievement.

# Why offer High Performance Learning Groups...

Some students need to be challenged at a higher level in Language Arts and Math as evidenced through classroom performance and work.

Students develop, refine and apply advance concepts and skills in High Performance learning groups.



In High Performance learning groups, students study, practice and apply concepts and processes at a level and pace appropriate to their needs.

## *High Performance Language Arts students ...*

- ★ Read and write in various genres and forms
- ★ Analyze and evaluate reading material
- ★ Make connections between the world they read about and the world they know
- ★ Communicate about what they read in different ways
- ★ Use reading to develop new skills and knowledge

## *High Performance Math students ...*

- ★ Think, ask questions about and respond to a rich variety of math problems and situations
- ★ Expand their capacity to recognize, solve and communicate about complex, relevant math problems
- ★ Strengthen math reasoning abilities
- ★ Build on math knowledge to develop new skills and interests



## Placing Students in High Performance Groups

Teachers ask a variety of questions to determine if students would benefit from a High Performance learning group. They draw from the following sources for answers:

- ★ Tests including CPM's, the NWEA, and classroom based assessments.
- ★ Teacher and parent impressions gathered from a checklist.
- ★ Classroom Performance: assessments, projects and other evidence generated by students in classroom work.
