

Early Childhood Screening

The early childhood years from birth to the start of kindergarten are an important time of rapid learning and growth. Early Childhood Screening is a quick and simple check of how your child is doing at 3½ or 4 years old. Screening identifies, at an early age, possible health or learning concerns, so that children can get help before starting kindergarten.

A qualified nurse will check your child's vision, hearing, physical growth, immunization status and skills in thinking, communication, large and small muscle and social and emotional development. You'll be given a full report of your child's learning and growth. Information to support your job as parent will also be available.

Screening is required for admittance to public school kindergarten. Early Childhood Screening is offered at no cost at Pike Lake Education Center in New Brighton.
