

Mounds View Public Schools Board Governance Policy

BG-0200 Public Engagement

One of the primary roles of the School Board is to engage the public in discussion regarding education in Mounds View Public Schools. The School Board will provide for public engagement in a variety of settings, forums and processes on an ongoing basis.

Another key role of the Board is to visibly support community engagement charged to and facilitated by the administration and/or external resources. In such situations, the role of Board members is to:

- Be present as requested by the Board
- Welcome community members and express gratitude for participation and support of the process
- Do not actively engage in or influence community discussion. Either leave the meeting (typical for a building event), or listen to discussions without sitting down or joining groups (typical for a district event).

Rationale:

Residents of the Mounds View Public School District are the stakeholders. Their involvement in major decisions is a valuable form of assistance to the School Board.
