

Mounds View Public Schools Board Governance Policy

BG-0404 Process for Addressing School Board Member Violations

The School Board and its members are committed to faithful compliance with the provisions of the School Board's policies. In the event of a member's willful and continuing violation of policy, the School Board will seek remedy by the following process in the sequence articulated:

- a. Conversation in a private setting between the offending member and the School Board Chair or other individual member; such conversation will be reported to the balance of the Board
- b. Discussion in a public meeting between the offending member and the full School Board
- c. Public censure of the offending member of the School Board

Most of the issues and situations are intended to fall into Category A. Category B and C are intended for extreme and/or repeated instances of violations where process step A has not resulted in a change in member behaviors.

Monitoring Method: School Board self-assessment

Monitoring Frequency: Semi-annual in May and December

Rationale:

School Board members need to operate within the common and sensible boundaries.
