### NEW EVENING COURSE! FENCING

*At Island Lake Elementary School*

Join the fast-growing Olympic sport of fencing. Each Youth Enrichment League (YEL) fencing class follows four basic components: 1. Teach It! Hall of Fame Olympic fencing coach Ro Sobalvarro crafts the lessons and curriculum. 2. Practice It! Students pair up to practice a fencing move or concept, rotate partners and repeat. 3. Move It! Students then participate in fencing matches using only the moves taught so far. 4. Play It! Spend 10-15 minutes of each class fencing with multiple fencers at their skill level. All equipment is provided.
