


## Island Lake Elementary Fall learning model family survey results

We recently invited parents to provide feedback on the learning model(s) they participated in this fall/winter. Here's what we learned from those who participated in the survey.

- **Most families are satisfied that Island Lake is doing its best to serve all students and families.**

Of the 309 families that responded,

- 58% were very satisfied
- 30% were somewhat satisfied
- 7% were somewhat dissatisfied
- 5% were very dissatisfied

### Feedback from families who participated in blended learning this fall:

- 83% of Island Lake families were satisfied with the blended learning model.
- 86% of the families thought Island Lake had the right amount of safety measures to keep students and staff healthy.
- 95% of the Island Lake families thought the safety measures were easy for their child to follow.
