BACKGROUND *(If necessary, additional information is attached)*

The next step in the Levy Limitation and Certification process is for the school board to certify a final 2021 property tax levy. The final certification is forwarded to Ramsey County for processing of the final property tax statements. The tax statements are mailed out in March 2021. The property tax revenue is collected in 2021 and will be available to the District for the 2021-2022 school year. Final taxes for 2021 total \$62,526,556, which is \$587,411 or approximately 1% less than 2020 final taxes.

ADMINISTRATIVE RECOMMENDATION

Administration recommends that final taxes levied in 2020 and collected in 2021 is set at \$62,526,556 per the adoption of the attached resolution.

RESOLUTION FOR TAXES PAYABLE 2021

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes the School Board of Independent School District 621, is authorized to make the following proposed tax levies for general purposes:

General Fund	\$42,392,593
Community Service Fund	1,012,387
Debt Service Fund	<u>19,121,576</u>
Final Proposed School Tax Levy	\$62,526,556
