

HEALTH & SAFETY REMINDERS

We are excited to have students back in our building! Please remember that the health practices in place prior to our shift to distance learning are still important to help us create a school environment that's as healthy and safe as we can.

Stay Home When Sick

If a student is ill, or has an ill person in their household, please stay home. If a student becomes ill at school, parents will be asked to pick up the student immediately. Report any illnesses, COVID-19 close contact exposures and positive cases within the home to the **Chippewa Health Office: (651) 621-6404**.

Screening

Chippewa families are expected to self screen at home daily before coming to school:

1. Does your student have ONE OR MORE of these symptoms?

- Fever of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher
- Difficulty/hard time breathing
- New cough or a cough that gets worse
- New loss of taste or smell

If a student has one or more of these symptoms, they must stay home. Please notify **the health office at (651) 621-6404**. Please be advised that other adults and children living in the house need to stay home as well.

2. Does your student have AT LEAST TWO of these symptoms?

If a student has at least two of these symptoms, they must stay home. Please **notify the health office at (651) 621-6404**. Please be advised that other adults and children living in the house need to stay home as well.

3. Is anyone in your household ill, awaiting Covid test results (because of symptoms or close contact with a positive case), or recently tested positive for Covid-19?

If any of these situations are true for your household then your student will need to stay home. **Please notify the health office at (651) 621-6404**. Please be advised that all other adults and children living in the house need to stay home as well.
